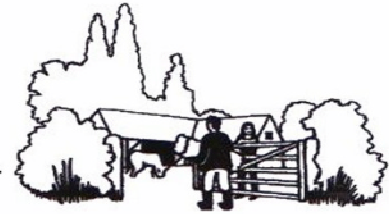

ABOUT MFT. MFT was founded in the autumn 1996 with the aim of providing adults with learning disabilities work and training opportunities in farming, conservation and rural skills within Suffolk. Initially this would take place on host farms with the ultimate aim of acquiring our own farm.

M.F.T. have a tenancy of a refurbished workshop and 2 acres of land at Rede Hall Farm, near Bury St. Edmunds. A variety of vegetables and soft fruit are grown and sold. In the workshop woodwork projects plus tool and machinery maintenance are undertaken. MFT also works at Old Hall East Bergholt. Here tractor driving, land cultivation and caring for a range of livestock are some of the jobs the MFT team do. Conservation takes place at both farms and external sites. Future plans include increasing the number of workdays, providing opportunities for additional farmworkers, developing rural skills workshops and undertaking paid contract work.
